

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the scalarider Oz® Bluetooth® entertainment system for motorcycle helmets. This manual will help you set up. configure and operate it.



2. CHARGING THE SCALARIDER

Make sure that your scalarider is fully charged for at least 4 hours before initial use



Charging with the wall charger is faster than via a computer USB port.

• RED LED ON – Charging • RED LED OFF – Charging complete

Battery In Standby, press **⊕** for 2 seconds Check • BLUE = Full • PURPLE = Half • RED = Almost empty



The scalarider Qz is waterproof and dustproof. However, when in use, the USB silicone cover should be kept tightly closed to prevent moisture from entering the unit.

4. GETTING STARTED

4.1 STATUS LIGHTS

None	scalarider is OFF
1 BLUE flash every 3 seconds	Standby mode No active audio sources
2 BLUE flashes every 3 seconds	Active mode – Call in progress / music or other audio source is ON
1 RED flash every 3 seconds	Standby mode – Battery is low
2 RED flashes every 3 seconds	Active mode – Battery is low
Solid RED	Charging



4.2 GENERAL FUNCTIONS

Power ON / OFF	Press of for 2 seconds ON: 3 BLUE flashes + Ascending tone OFF: 3 RED flashes + Descending tone
Volume	Tap ② or ○ to adjust and set volume of current audio source
Mute	Tap ⊕ and ⊝ simultaneously
Battery Check	In Standby, press ⊕ for 2 seconds: • BLUE LED = Full charge • PURPLE LED = Half charge • RED LED = Almost empty
Enable/Disable Spoken Status Announcements (Enabled by default)	Via the Cardo Community

4.3 AUDIO SOURCES AND PRIORITIES

If two connected audio sources try to play audio simultaneously, your scala rider automatically determines which audio source to play through the speakers based on the priority of the connected devices.

Higher Priority



- 1. Mobile Phone audio or GPS instructions*
- 2. A2DP (Stereo Bluetooth) audio
- 3. AUX (for corded connection to MP3 Players)

* GPS instructions from Smartphone GPS Apps are prioritized like A2DP audio

Lower Priority

Incoming mobile phone calls interrupt ongoing A2DP music



4.4 SETTINGS

Customize various settings according to your preferences:

- Spoken Status Announcements (default: ON)
- AGC sensitivity level for the speakers (default: Medium)
- **VOX sensitivity level** for the microphone (default: Medium) Change settings via the *Cardo Community* platform at **http://community.cardosystems.com** (see section 3).

4.5 VOICE CONNECT (VOX)

Your scalarider offers VOX technology for hands-free operation.

VOX Activation	Speak any word loudly into the microphone
Answer a call	Speak any word loudly into the microphone
Reject a call	Remain silent for about 15 seconds
VOX Sensitivity (Default: Regular)	Adjust via the Cardo Community. High: Use this setting if it is difficult to activate VOX Low: Use this setting if it is too easy to activate VOX



5. PAIRING AND USING A MOBILE PHONE, GPS **DEVICE OR MP3 PLAYER**









To connect your scalarider to a *Bluetooth* device you must first pair them. Once paired, they will automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range (10m / 33ft).

Your scalarider has two Bluetooth channels for connection to mobile phones, GPS devices and music players with A2DP.

5.1 PAIRING BUILTOOTH CHANNELS 1 AND 2

- 1. Make sure *Bluetooth* is enabled on your phone/GPS/MP3 player.
- 2. Check the scalarider is in Standby (single BLUE flash every 3 seconds).
- 3. To pair Bluetooth Channel 1 press of for at least 5 seconds until the RED and BLUE LEDs begin rapidly alternating. To pair Bluetooth Channel 2 – press \bigcirc for at least 5 seconds until the RED and BLUE LEDs begin rapidly alternating.
- 4. Search for Bluetooth devices on your phone/GPS/MP3 player by following the device's instructions.
- 5. After a few seconds the device will list "scalarider Oz". Select it.
- 6. If prompted for a PIN or Passkey, enter 0000 (four zeros).
- 7. The device will confirm that pairing has succeeded and the scalarider will begin flashing slowly in BLUE.
- 8. If Pairing is not completed within 2 minutes, the scalarider will return to Standby mode.



NOTES:

• If your GPS supports it, you can pair the second mobile phone directly to the GPS and then pair the GPS to your scalarider, and so connect both mobile phones and the GPS to your scalarider.

 Not all Bluetooth mobile phones can broadcast Bluetooth Stereo music (A2DP), even if the phone has an MP3 player function.
 Consult your mobile phone's User Manual for more information.

- Not all Bluetooth GPS devices allow connection to Bluetooth audio devices. Consult your GPS User Manual for more information.
- After pairing, you may need to tap 🛂 to connect the scalarider.

5.2 MAKING AND RECEIVING PHONE CALLS

Answer a call	Tap ■ or say any word loudly to answer by VOX
Reject a call	Remain silent for 15 seconds, or press and hold 1 for 2 seconds
End a call	Тар 🕽
Voice Dial* (if supported by mobile phone)	Tap ■ and (simultaneously and follow the prompt from the mobile
Redial*	Press and for 2 seconds
Hot-Dial**	Tap ▶ three times
Set default phone***	When on a phone call, press 9 for 5 seconds
Toggle default phone***	In Standby, press 1 for 5 seconds

^{*}This feature is not available during mobile calls

^{**}To use the Hot-Dial feature, first configure the number via the *Cardo Community*.

^{***} If you have 2 mobile phones paired directly to your scala rider, you will need to set one of them to use as default for outgoing calls.



5.3 LISTENING TO MUSIC VIA A2DP





The scala rider can also receive audio via a cable from non-Bluetooth MP3 Players or audio sources as described in section 5.4

Available only on AVRCP compatible Bluetooth audio sources	
Play	In Standby, tap 🖸
Pause/Stop	Press 1 for 2 seconds
Next Track	With music ON, tap 🛂
Previous Track*	With music ON, double tap 🛂

^{*}With some phones you may need to repeat this action

SWITCHING RETWEEN A2DP AUDIO SOURCES

- 1. Stop the music playback from the current device.
- 2. Start music playback from the other device.

5.4 CABLE-CONNECTED MP3 PLAYERS

The USB Port can be used to connect a non-Bluetooth audio source using the connector cable (available for purchase separately).



- 1. Check that the scalarider is in Standby.
- 2. Connect the MP3 cable to the Music Player's lack and insert the other end into the USB Port.

To listen to music from a cable-connected device, operate the Music Player using its buttons as usual (FF/REW/PLAY/PAUSE).



6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Reboot	If your scalarider stops responding, reset it by turning it off and then on again (press b for 2 seconds).
Reset Pairing (Deletes all paired devices)	I. In Standby, press for 5 secs until LED flashes RED/BLUE. Press for 2 seconds until LED flashes 5 times in PURPLE.
